Defense Acquisition University Announces the Release of the Requirements Document Wizard, Version 1.3

What's New?

The Requirements Document Wizard (RDW), Version 1.3 brings you a host of new capabilities, as well as new document templates.

New capabilities and features include:

- New templates that complete the entire breadth of required JCIDS documents, including:
 - Initial Capabilities Document (ICD)
 - Capability Development Document (CDD)
 - Joint Urgent Operational Need/Joint Emergent Operational Need (JUON/JEON)
 - DOTmLPF-P Change Recommendation (DCR)
 - Information Systems Initial Capabilities Document (IS-ICD)
 - Software Initial Capabilities Document (SW-ICD)
 - Information Systems Capability Development Document (IS-CDD)
 - Capability Development Document Increment/Annex (CDD-Increment/CDD-Annex).
- The ability to incorporate new and updated templates over time DIRECTLY—without involving your IT Help Desk
- An improved acronym finder, to surface acronyms in support of your document's required appendix
- Additional documents accessible directly within the program, including:
 - Cyber Survivability Endorsement Guide, version 3.0
 - Electromagnetic Spectrum Survivability Guidebook, version 2.0
 - DoD Dictionary of Military and Associated Terms

Administrative changes and bug fixes include:

- Enhanced and corrected document classification markings and portion markings
- Updated folder naming convention for ease of identification and use
- Enumerating Appendix pages with A-1, A-2, B-1, B-2, etc. to distinguish them from the base document
- The incorporation of the Technology Sharing Agreement as a pop-up upon initialization of the software

How do I Access RDW, Version 1.3?

There are two general paths to access this software.

• If your IT enclave already has access to RDW, Version 1.2

Approach your IT Help Desk and ask them to follow the same procedures they used in their initial testing, configuration control, and change management processes to make Version 1.2 available. Version 1.3 is available from the same [website](#). Your IT Help Desk may require you to support the process with a help ticket and/or completing their unique form requirements. ***Ask about also making it available on your SIPR enclave!

• If your IT enclave does not yet have access to RDW, Version 1.2

Approach your IT Help Desk with the information on in the RDW Access Guide, also found on this [website](#). Ask them to make it available to you and your entire network enclave. Please be aware that each IT enclave has its own unique testing, configuration control, and change management processes, and the process may take some time. Be prepared to support this request as they require—but be assured that the RDW team is ready to help and answer technical questions, as required by your or your IT Help Desk. ***Ask about also making it available on your SIPR enclave!
