Warfighting Acquisition University Announces the Release of the Requirements Document Wizard, Version 2.0

What's New?

The Requirements Document Wizard (RDW), Version 2.0 brings you a host of new capabilities, as well as new document templates.

New capabilities and features include:

- **8 NEW** templates, including:
 - 5 document templates for the five proscribed documents in the JFRP Manual, including:
 - Capstone Requirements Document (CRD)
 - Joint DOTmLPF-P Request (JDCR)
 - Combatant Command Derived Requirement (CDR)
 - Joint Urgent Operational Need / Joint Emergent Operational Need (JUON/JEON)
 - Assessment of Operational Utility (AOU)
 - 2 Software Acquisition Pathway (DoDI 5000.87) related documents:
 - Capability Needs Statement (CNS)
 - User Agreement (UA)
 - 1 Service-specific requirements document:
 - USSF's Solution Pathway Review (SPR)
- The Template Design Tool (TDT) which enables select users (template sponsors) to easily design and maintain new templates on their own
- Enhanced error logging to meet security parameters and improve debugging.

Administrative changes, enhancements, and bug fixes include:

- Improved functionality of Edit Project user interface to increase loading speed.
- Updated documents in Additional Resources folder.
- Updated process for MS Word document generation to improve application crashing and errors.

How do I Access RDW, Version 2.0?

There are two general paths to access this software.

- **If your IT enclave already has access to RDW, Version 1.2 or Version 1.3**

Approach your IT Help Desk and ask them to follow the same procedures they used in their initial testing, configuration control, and change management processes to make the previous version available. Version 2.0 is available from the same website. Your IT Help Desk may require you to support the process with a help ticket and/or completing their unique form requirements. ***Ask about also making it available on your SIPR enclave!

- **If your IT enclave does not yet have access to RDW, Version 1.2 or Version 1.3**

Approach your IT Help Desk with the information on in the RDW Access Guide, also found on this website. Ask them to make it available to you and your entire network enclave. Please be aware that each IT enclave has its own unique testing, configuration control, and change management processes, and the process may take some time. Be prepared to support this request as they require—but be assured that the RDW team is ready to help and answer technical questions, as required by your or your IT Help Desk. ***Ask about also making it available on your SIPR enclave!
